Since the beginning of the school, we have known only a heart full of aspirations, and it is this knowledge that has given us the drive to move forward until excellence is attained in all of our endeavours.

- 1."Our school's primary focus is academics. We have made every effort we can to ensure academic excellence in our school, and we will keep doing so. We consider academic excellence to be the hallmark of our school's status as a good institution".
2. This session began with the Orientation Programme for the parents of the students in classes Pre-Primary through IX, as is customary every year. The programme made the parents aware of the scheme of education we impart here at our school. Our Principal's question-and-answer session enlightened the way to effective parenting.
3. Having a fully digitalize school has many benefits for parents, teachers, and the institution itself. Through WHAT'SAPP Broadcast on Android and Apple mobile devices, parents can keep track of their child's status in real-time for things like daily attendance, fee status, periodic results, school circulars and news, etc. For regular updates on their children, parents can speak directly with the class teacher, and cases that require individualized attention can be escalated through the use of an easy communication channel.
4. The curriculum was adjusted for online instruction. There will be significant curriculum changes for the upcoming academic year. To improve the standard, the KG curriculum will be updated, modified, and enriched. Teaching will receive more focus, with speaking abilities and other skills receiving significant weight. Six indoor play stations with themed activities and an outdoor play station will improve the quality of the KG curriculum. Additionally, we will put a sufficient amount of

emphasis on games, art, dance, and music classes in KG. The KG timetable will also place equal emphasis on physical activities.

5. The overall attendance rate from July 2024 to September 2024 is 94.5%, and the average student attendance for the academic year 2023–2024 was 95%. 96% is our goal for the period 2024–2025. Typically, all students are on time for class. For students who have 100% annual attendance overall, certificates will be given out to encourage regular attendance. To reach this goal, we require our parents' cooperation and support.
6. Every effort has been made to guarantee high-quality instruction. During the current academic year, we selected qualified teachers, and the selection process for the following academic year is currently underway. We have a very effective system in place for observing teachers' lessons, which includes peer, group, and principal observation.
7. This direct upload of the daily homework to Whatsapp broadcast in parallel with what is given in the classroom has improved communication between parents and teachers. This allows parents to be informed of the daily homework assigned in the classroom and to enforce it at home.
8. This year, we made a significant advancement in the examination process by switching from the customary system of manually created Report Cards by the teachers to Computer Generated Report Cards. This change reduced the amount of work required of the teachers to manually complete the Report-Cards. The Term Wise Planner had been properly finalized and distributed for the five segments, Formative Assessments-1, Formative Assessments-2, Summative Assessment-1 Examinations, Formative Assessments-3, and the Summative Assessment-2.
9. Participation in competitions is what counts, and we learn from both wins and losses. Inter-school, inter-house, and inter-class competitions in things like debates, quizzes, rangolis, declarations, creative writing, spelling bees, rhyme and metre, and drawing were enough to create this environment. Our students participated in various intra-school competitions and State selections organized by the government brought honour to the school by winning in kho-kho, yoga, Kabaddi & Volley-Ball.
10. As of this year, we have started to give our students their first exposure to democracy and leadership skills through activities that are entirely dependent on their academic performance, attendance, and athletic prowess. On I. Independence Day, elected officials received pins for their badges..

11. Holidays like Colour Days, Father's Day, Teachers' Day, International Literacy Day, Children's Day, Makhara Sankranti, Republic Day, Sree Krishna Janma Asthami, etc.
12. HEALTH AND SAFETY: Ingenious inter-house sports competitions and International Yoga Day were held..
13. Secondary language options: For students in Grades 1 and up, the school offers Hindi and Telugu as secondary language options. Starting in Grade 5, students have access to the III Language option..
14. To prepare the tiny tots for the next stage of formal schooling, the Pre-Primary Graduation Ceremony was held, complete with certificates and convocation.
15. This year's academic fair celebrations took a unique turn when teachers from the school banded together, took the initiative, and made the event a huge success.
16. The school is successfully operating the semi-residential block, and starting in 2022, we promise to finish the residential block and resume providing boarding facilities with first-rate amenities like:
 - A cafeteria serving wholesome meals
 - B. Matron and patron service available around-the-clock
 - C. Study plans and free time during downtime
 - D. An onboard nurse
 - E. Well-trained and experienced staff to handle emergency needs

The lab activities were fully prepared and carried out to demonstrate the calibre of our students in the fields of science, IT, art, social science, and math.
